Yankee Point Marina 2024 Hurricane Haul Out Plan

Tuesday, July 9, 2024

Dear slip holders and customers of Yankee Point Marina,

With the recent passage of Hurricane Beryl, we have been met with renewed questions about the hurricane plan for this year. In consultation with our own insurance provider we have finalized the criteria for this season.

Overview

In the event of a named storm, every vessel at Yankee Point Marina must either haul out or vacate their slip. Priority will be given to slip holders for haul out services. We will have maximum availability for 70 vessels, once slip holders have made their plans we will open the list to other customers in the area.

Confirmation and Liability

All slip holders must provide written confirmation if they intend to be on the haul out list. If you choose not to be on the haul out list and do not remove your vessel from the slips at the marina, you will be liable for any and all damages sustained by the marina as a result of your vessel being left in the slip. Vessel owners who do not keep their vessels at Yankee Point and who wish to be hauled must put their names on the list through an email. They also must be able to move their vessel at the dictated time; we will not allow customers to drop their vessels off days in advance. All vessels being hauled at Yankee Point are required to have a minimum of \$500,000 in liability coverage and a copy of your policy needs to be included with your request.

Haul Out Order and Rates

- Order of Haul Out: Will be determined by vessels who request services and will be finalized by the boat yard.

Rates:

- Mono Hulls: \$20.00 per foot with a minimum charge of \$600.
- Catamarans: \$30.00 per foot with a minimum charge of \$900.
- Power washing and launch are not included.
- Head sails must be removed prior to haul out; if the yard completes this, hourly charges will apply.
- Labor rates during this time will be at overtime rates of \$175 per hour.

Preparation

We encourage all customers to:

- Remove any and all canvas.
- Secure any tenders. Tenders will not be permitted on the ground below your vessel.
- Ensure halyards are tied away from mast



- Loose equipment is stowed and secured.

Yankee Point will not be responsible for damage caused to or by equipment and/or appurtenances of any vessel stored at the marina.

Acceptance of Terms

By placing yourself on the hurricane haul out list, you accept the above terms in addition to all standard terms and conditions at Yankee Point Marina.
